Getting Started with Arduino

Arduino is a microcontroller development board – a cheap little computer you can programme to read sensors and control things like motors and lights. It's a fantastic tool for artists, designers and hobbyists.

This workshop will get you up and running with this hugely adaptable technology, showing you how to program the device and make simple electronic circuits. The course fee includes a complete Arduino kit – yours to keep after the workshop.
