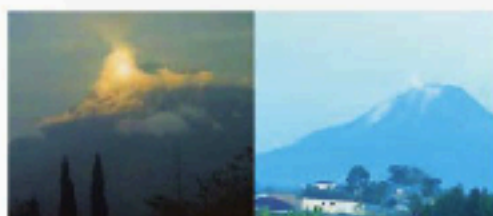
The Onesie Cycle VIP
